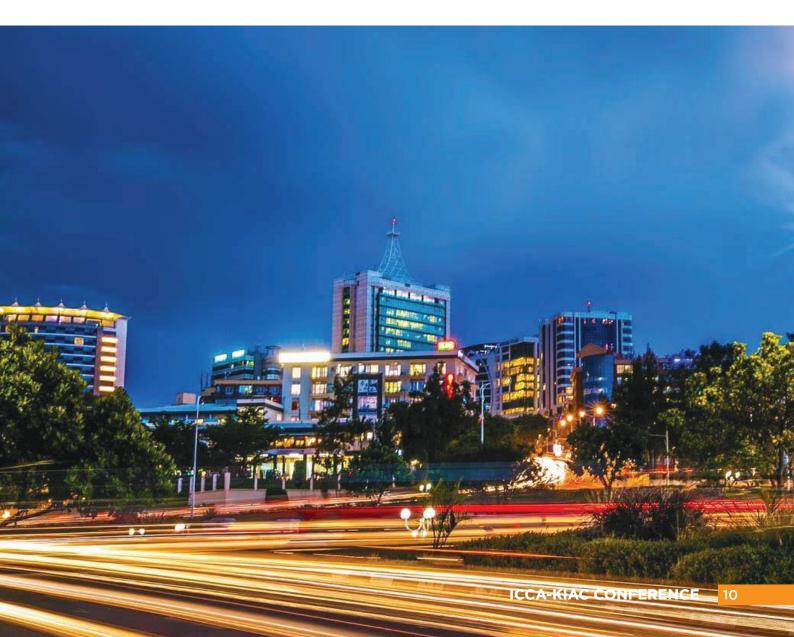
2. Kigali City

Kigali offers delegates a unique Africa experience guaranteeing classic modernity, exceptional cleanliness and safety.





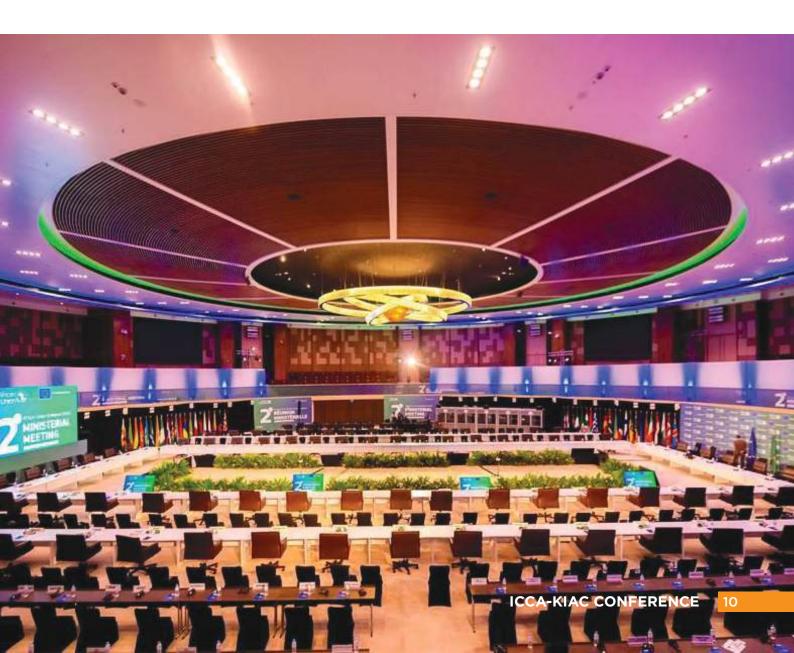
3. The Venue
